Bill Analysis

SB 1723 creates the Oklahoma Time Taken, Time Back Act. The measure directs the court to order additional periods of visitation or custody access to compensate for a denial of court-ordered visitation or custody access that resulted from an investigation conducted by the Department of Human Services, protective orders, or investigations conducted by an investigative agency. Such visitation shall be of the same type and duration as the visitation or custody access that was denied, may include weekends and holidays, and must occur within 2 years of the date the court-ordered visitation or custody access was denied. The person denied visitation shall be authorized to select the time of the additional visitation or custody access.
