Bill Analysis

SB 1728 defines coercive control as it relates to the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act and in the Domestic Abuse Reporting Act. The measure provides that coercive control shall include intentional isolation from family and other sources of support, deprivation of basic necessities, monitoring movements and communications, the use of immigration status to coerce or threaten, acts of animal cruelty, forced sex acts, demands that limit free will, and aiding a suicide.
