Bill Analysis

SB 1730 directs the law enforcement officer who receives a report or complaint that, if substantiated, would result in the defendant being required to register as a sex offender, to submit a record of the complaint or report to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation within 1 month of the report's receipt. The measure requires the record to include the name or identifying information of the accused, the nature of the alleged offense, the date, time, and location of the alleged offense, and the agency report number. The report shall be submitted regardless of whether an arrest is made. The report shall not be made publicly available.
