**Bill Analysis**

SB 1734 creates the Oklahoma Responsible Technology in Schools Act. It prohibits artificial intelligence tools from being used in public school districts for instructional or educational purposes except through educator-directed use. It provides guidelines for use of classroom AI tools. It directs the State Department of Education to develop guidance regarding responsible use of artificial intelligence and emerging technologies, and it directs school district boards of education to adopt policies governing such use prior to the beginning of the 2027-2028 school year.
