**Bill Analysis**

SB 1748 requires food trucks to be in compliance with the fire code that was in effect at the time of the most recent inspection of the mobile food preparation vehicle instead of the most current code. The vehicle must remain in compliance with that code for a period of at least 10 years from the date of the most recent inspection. After the 10-year period, the inspection shall be based on the most current code.
