**Bill Analysis**

SB 1758 authorizes parties to a civil procedure to appeal an order that grants, modifies, denies, or refuses a temporary order in any suit affecting the parent-child relationship. Such parties must file such an appeal within 20 days of the date the temporary order was signed. The measure authorizes the appellate court to extend the filing period by 10 days if shown good cause. The measure requires such an appeal to be given priority by the court.
