Bill Analysis

SB 1759 prohibits the state and any political subdivision from enacting a ranked choice voting system. Any ordinances adopted by a political subdivision to this effect shall be void. This prohibition shall not apply to the internal primaries of political parties. The Attorney General shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this measure. The measure authorizes aggrieved individuals to bring a civil action for declaratory or injunctive relief.
