Bill Analysis

SB 1760 requires the court to conduct a nonjury trial to determine whether the state has met the burden of beyond a reasonable doubt that the factual allegations in the petition that a child is deprived are true and correct. The measure also changed the burden of proof from preponderance of the evidence to beyond a reasonable doubt. The measure strikes language authorizing the court to accept a stipulation by the child's parent, guardian, or other legal custodian that the facts alleged in the petition are true and correct.
