Bill Analysis

SB 1767 authorizes the Attorney General to bring civil action in federal district court and state court to seek injunctive relief if any person or retailer ships alcoholic beverages in the state or receives payments for fulfilling any orders that are not authorized by law. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission is authorized to investigate and assist the Attorney General. Out-of-state retailers in violation of state law shall be subject to a \$5,000.00-\$25,000.00 fine per violation as well as treble damages equivalent to the retail value of the alcoholic beverages shipped. The measure also creates the Alcohol Enforcement and Regulatory Revolving Fund.
