**Bill Analysis**

SB 1775 clarifies that for any traffic-related, alcohol-related, and drug-related offenses with a penalty established by statute, a municipal ordinance may impose a penalty that is less than or equal to the penalty established by statute for the same offense. The measure caps all other municipal fines that are not listed in state law at \$200.00 for traffic-related offenses, at \$800.00 for alcohol-related or drug-related offenses, and at \$750.00 for all other offenses.
