**Bill Analysis**

SB 1784 creates the Oklahoma State Protection from Terrorist Organizations Act. The measure authorizes the Governor to designate an organization as a designated terrorist organization for state administrative purposes upon written recommendations from the Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, and the Office of the Attorney General. The designation shall prohibit any state agency from awarding or renewing contracts with the entity. The measure prohibits designated entities from acquiring or holding property. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to seek injunctive relief, contract voidance, recovery of misspent funds, and other equitable remedies for violations. The measure authorizes designated entities to seek judicial review. Removal petitions may be filed after 24 months or earlier upon materially changed circumstances.
