Bill Analysis

SB 1785 creates the Citizen's Bill of Rights. The measure prohibits the government and any business from forcing any digital monetary system on the citizenry without providing equally viable and useful alternative options for the citizenry to obtain goods and services. Such entities may not use a digital monetary system to control or monitor the habits of citizens. The measure prohibits financial institutions from restricting or denying legitimately earned digital funds from being used for goods and services based on certain traits or from being used to support political parties. The measure prohibits the creation or use of any social credit score. The measure prohibits the government from tracking carbon usage or penalizing the use of personal gardens. The measure prohibits the government from using artificial intelligence (AI) to make determinations relating to life and death as well as who shall receive medical care. AI may not be used to replace a worker unless the worker is employed by the government in another area. The measure provides that a replaced worker shall receive 6 months' pay and benefits. The measure provides that violators may be held liable by a court of competent jurisdiction.
