**Bill Analysis**

SB 1791 creates the Active and Retired Military Outdoor Recreation Days (ARMOR) Act. The measure directs the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission and the Military Department to identify state parks that can be designated as veteran and active-duty personnel access areas for recreational use. Such parks must be easily accessible and equipped with necessary facilities as well as equipped to handle veterans with disabilities. Designated areas may only be used by veterans on specific days or weekends as determined by the Commission and Department. The Commission and Department shall also host community events on such days.
