**Bill Analysis**

SB 1793 prohibits the disbursement of public funds to any entity, organization, health care provider, or individual that provides or refers for gender transition procedures. The measure provides that state employees who provide funding to such entities shall be subject to disciplinary procedures. The measure creates a misdemeanor for any health care provider who provides or refers patients to gender transition procedures and subjects such a person to a fine of \$1,000.00-\$10,000.00 fine and/or a term of imprisonment of 1 month-1year.
