**Bill Analysis**

SB 1795 provides that members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System, Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System, Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma, or The Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges who are charged with a felony shall lose the right to access, withdraw from, or liquidate their retirement benefits. The measure requires prosecuting attorneys to notify the relevant system within 48 hours of filing charges. If found not guilty, the access shall be restored.
