Bill Analysis

SB 1800 provides that if an employee of a school district is subject to an investigation for possible sexual abuse or exploitation or has been charged with such crimes, the law enforcement agency shall notify the school superintendent and the members of the school board. Upon receiving such notice, the employee shall be suspended without notice or hearing, though the employee shall continue to receive compensation they were otherwise entitled to. The suspension shall continue until the investigation or case concludes. The superintendent shall also notify the parents and legal guardians of students enrolled in the school. The notification shall include the statement that the employee is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
