Bill Analysis

SB 1810 provides that in any action in a court, if a party offers evidence of human trafficking, testimony of an expert witness including effect of such human trafficking on the beliefs, behavior, and perception of the person being trafficked shall be admissible as evidence. Additionally, the measure expands the scope of the Victims Services Unit to include human trafficking victims.
