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Bill Analysis

SB 1818 requires any person or entity engaging in commerce industrial, municipal, and commercial operations to disclose the use of biosolids. A biosolid is defined by the measure as a sludge, perfluoroalkyl, and any polyfluoroalkyl substance. Any product that uses biosolids in its manufacturing process shall be required to disclose such using clear and distinct labeling. Users of biosolids shall also be required to place signage on any property where such operations take place and where biosolids are utilized. The measure provides for a 1-year restriction on the land if the property is sold. The measure directs the Department of Environmental Quality to publish and update annually a map of biosolid land application property sites on a publicly available website. The measure directs the Department along with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to provide written notice of the biosolid use to businesses conducting agritourism activities of any biosolid land application taking place within a 4-mile radius of the business.

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
