Bill Analysis

SB 1820 creates an affirmative defense for persons who engaged in dueling that did not result in serious bodily harm. Serious bodily harm is defined by the measure as any harm that creates a substantial risk of death or that causes death, serious permanent disfigurement, protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or prolonged impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ. The measure requires the consent of all parties involved in the duel to qualify for the affirmative defense.
