Bill Analysis

SB 1844 creates the Hope for Oklahoma Patients Act. The measure authorizes any manufacturer operating under all Federalwide Assurance (FWA) for the Protection of Human Subjects regulations and rules to make available an individualized investigational treatment for patients requesting such treatments. Such manufacturers may also provide investigational treatments to patients without compensation. The provisions of the measure shall not require the expansion of insurance coverage to include such treatments or require any government entity to pay for such treatments. The measure provides immunity to liability to the patient's estate, heirs, and devisees if experimental treatments result in the patient's death. This immunity shall not apply when applying nonexperimental treatments to the patient. The measure prohibits any medical licensing board from revoking or suspending the license of a practitioner who recommends such treatment.
