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Bill Analysis

SB 1847 lowers the qualifying minimum age for Medicaid from 21 years of age to 19 years of age. The measure also provides that a person with a cognitive impairment may qualify for the ADvantage Waiver Program if the person resides in or is already residing in an assisted living center. The measure authorizes assisted living centers to a plan of accommodation with the cognitively impaired person.

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
