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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1877 directs the Office of the Secretary of State to create and maintain a centralized filing system for all reports required by statute to be submitted to the system. The filing system shall provide an indexing system of statutorily required reports as well as a dashboard reflecting whether a report has been submitted or is overdue. The measure directs the Secretary of State to electronically report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, and the Governor if an agency or entity has not submitted a statutorily required report to the system. The measure also repeals obsolete language relating to various reports and databases.
