Bill Analysis

SB 1880 requires any employee of the Department of Human Services or other child welfare worker that testifies under oath and knowingly or recklessly provides inaccurate, misleading, or false information to be placed on a list that may be used as evidence to evaluate the truthfulness of such employee or worker. The measure provides for all parties to a deprivation hearing to be given notice of the list and its members. The list shall also be publicly available.
