**Bill Analysis**

SB 1887 directs training for teachers and school employees on food allergies, recognizing anaphylaxis, and instruction on how to administer epinephrine to be completed the first year a teacher or school employee is employed and once every other academic year thereafter. The measure also directs concussion training to be completed by game and team officials the first year such an official is employed by or volunteers for a school district or youth sports organization and once every other academic year thereafter.
