**Bill Analysis**

SB 1888 requires any school athletic association of which school districts are members to submit any rules or amendments to rules governing interscholastic activities or contents to the Legislature for review. The bill provides a process for review, approval in whole or in part, and disapproval in whole or in part of the rules. Additionally, the bill directs a school athletic association to have a policy allowing a student who transfers to a public school to participate in interscholastic activities or contents upon enrollment. It repeals a section of law requiring a one-year waiting period prior to participating in such activities or contents after a transfer.
