**Bill Analysis**

SB 1893 creates the Teacher Shortage Reduction Act. It directs school districts to implement an education endorsement graduation recognition beginning in the 2027-2028 school year for students who have met the graduation requirements, identified teaching or another education profession as a career goal on their individual career and academic plan, and participated in an apprenticeship, internship, or mentorship related to teaching or another education profession. It also directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to implement an education designation for students who earn an education endorsement graduation recognition and who graduate with thirty or more college credit hours or an associate's degree through concurrent enrollment at a state institution of higher education.

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
