Bill Analysis

SB 1897 directs the State Board of Education to amend its Every Student Succeeds Act consolidated state plan to allow school districts to choose from a list of approved assessments to administer to students in grades nine through twelve. It directs the Board to issue a request for proposals for the selection of additional assessments to comply with ESSA. It states that beginning in the 2027-2028 school year, districts can choose an assessment from a list of approved assessments as long as the same assessment is administered to all students in grades nine through twelve in the district.
