**Bill Analysis**

SB 1899 modifies the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP), also known as Oklahoma's Promise. It expands eligibility to children of certified personnel of school districts who apply for participation beginning in the 2026-2027 school year. It defines "certified personnel" as someone who has been a certified, full-time principal, supervisor, administrator, counselor, librarian, or certified or registered nurse who has been employed in such position or as a certified classroom teacher for a minimum of 10 years prior to the child applying. The measure also repeals a duplicate version of law regarding eligibility for Oklahoma's Promise.
