Bill Analysis

SB 1900 requires any business entity receiving incentives or funding from the state for a project to provide at least 5% of the value of the incentives or funds to the political subdivision in which the project or entity, for which the funds are received, is located. If the project or entity is located in a municipality, the funding shall be provided to the municipality. If the project or entity is located outside of a municipality, the funding shall be provided to the county. The measure directs 75% of the funding to the municipality and 25% of the funding to the county if the project or entity is located outside of any town or municipality, but the entity or project utilizes the infrastructure of a town or municipality. Such funding received by municipalities and counties shall be expended on infrastructure.
