Bill Analysis

SB 1912 creates the Wrongful Life Act. The measure prohibits any health care professional from prescribing or performing gender transition therapy, hormone therapy, or puberty-blocking drugs unless such drugs are medically necessary. The measure authorizes a person to bring a civil action against any health care professional providing such services if such services caused the person to not be able to experience childbirth, the ability to impregnate, or the ability to breastfeed. A person who is a minor may bring forward such action throughout their minority. The measure creates a rebuttable presumption that the plaintiff, based solely on his or her age, would be able to experience childbirth, the ability to impregnate, and the ability to breastfeed if not for the gender transition surgery, hormone therapy, or puberty-blocking drugs. The measure also prohibits any parent or legal guardian from consenting to their child undergoing such procedures and provides for the child to bring forward civil action against his or her parent or legal guardian.
