**Bill Analysis**

SB 192 modifies the State Aid funding formula by directing calculations to be based on the weighted average daily membership for the school district based on the first 9 weeks of the current school year beginning in the 2026-2027 school year. The measure also directs the State Department of Education to administer a transitional grant program to provide transition grants to public school districts that receive a 5 percent reduction in State Aid allocations between the 2025-26 and 2026-2027 school years. It directs the Department to electronically submit a report by December 31, 2026, evaluating the financial impact of the State Aid calculation modifications, changes in educational outcomes correlated with the changes, and recommendations for further improvements to the State Aid funding formula.
