**Bill Analysis**

SB 1959 defines “playground” as it relates to the Highway Advertising Control Act of 1972. The measure defines a playground as an outdoor space that contains permanently affixed playground equipment where the primary use is for children to play, excluding those spaces where playground equipment is an accessory use to a commercial enterprise or is located on a privately owned residential property for use by the resident.

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
