**Bill Analysis**

SB 1969 enters the state into a multistate compact relating to massage therapy. The Compact shall create an Interstate Massage Compact Commission to manage a database comprised of each member state's licensed members. The compact provides that each state shall be entitled to 1 delegate on the Commission. Each member shall enter into a reciprocal license agreement and report adverse actions against licensees to the database. Each member state shall allow licensees to provide remote services. Each member agrees to maintain certain minimum standards for licensees. Each member agrees that certain crimes shall disqualify licensees.
