**Bill Analysis**

SB 2003 requires multiple occupancy changing rooms and restrooms in state institutions of higher education, technology center school districts, political subdivisions, and domestic violence shelters that are state operated or state funded to be designated for the exclusive use of the male or female sex. It provides exceptions. It prohibits an institution of higher education or technology center school district from requiring a student to share sleeping quarters with an individual of the opposite sex except under certain circumstances. It requires institutions of higher education to provide an option to be housed only with persons of the same sex. The measure also prohibits a school district or charter school from requiring a student to share sleeping quarters with a member of the opposite sex during any school-authorized activity or event except under certain circumstances.
