Bill Analysis

SB 2013 directs each law enforcement agency in the state to enter into an agreement with Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) to participate in the 287g Program. The 287g Program authorizes state law enforcement to perform certain duties relating to immigration under the supervision of federal authorities. Each law enforcement agency must apply for the program no later than September 1, 2026, and must maintain the program in good standing. Each agency shall ensure that no less than 25% of its personnel are authorized to perform authorized immigration enforcement functions. Any agency that fails to apply or maintain good standing with the program shall be ineligible to receive state funding.
