**Bill Analysis**

SB 2029 creates the Oklahoma Medical Freedom Act. The measure provides that the right of any individual to refuse a medical procedure, medical treatment, device, vaccine, or prophylactic shall not be questioned or interfered with in any manner. The measure provides that health care professionals who voice concerns or dissent regarding medical mandates, advocate for a patient's rights to informed consent, and discloses unethical practices shall be protected from disciplinary actions or loss of licensure. The measure creates a cause of action for aggrieved individuals.
