Bill Analysis

SB 2030 specifies that for the purposes of determining the period prior to eligibility for record expungement, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) shall consider records in its possession and deem sentences to have ended based on the sentence or supervision term length information in its possession. The measure directs the OSBI to develop a publicly accessible online portal for individuals to submit an expedited expungement request for records. The form shall only require enough personal information to enable the OSBI to search for the relevant records. The OSBI shall review the eligibility of each applicant and shall notify the applicant if he or she is eligible for expungement. Failure to notify the applicant or the applicant's disagreement with the OSBI's determination shall allow the applicant to file a petition with the district court. The measure also conforms multiple versions of statute and repeals a duplicate section.
