**Bill Analysis**

SB 2034 provides for the automatic expungement of a criminal record for any person convicted of a nonviolent misdemeanor if 10 years have passed since the conviction, the person has not been convicted of a felony, all fines and fees are paid, and the person has no pending felonies or misdemeanors. The prosecuting and arresting agency as well as interested persons may petition the court for an order unsealing the records.
