**Bill Analysis**

SB 2035 provides that any peace officer employed by the state or a political subdivision that, under the color of law, deprives a person of any individual rights that create binding obligations on government actors secured by the Bill of Rights, Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution shall be liable to the injured party. The measure specifies that statutory limitations and immunities on liability, damages, or attorney fees shall not apply to such claims. The measure also provides that if the employing agency finds that the officer did not act in good faith and upon a reasonable cause of action, the officer shall be personally liable for 5% of the judgement or \$25,000.00, whichever is less.
