Bill Analysis

SB 2044 requires any chiropractic physician who desires to administer vitamins, minerals, or nutritional supplements by means of injectable procedures to apply to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners for authorization. The measure requires such applicants to demonstrate that they have completed at least 120 hours of education and training in administration and use of such injectables. Such education and training must be approved by the board and be conducted under the auspices of and taught by the postgraduate faculty of an accredited college.
