**Bill Analysis**

SB 2047 modifies the terms of members of the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability. It directs the Commission to submit its report on the state's public education system on November 1, 2027, and every 3 years thereafter. It directs the Commission, rather than the State Board of Education, to take lead in conducting an educator supply-and-demand study. The measure directs the Commission to include information about workforce outcomes of high school graduates in its Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program report. It directs the Commission to be provided all data and reports necessary from the State Department of Education, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the State Board of Career and Technology Education, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, and any state contractor or assessment vendor that maintains data. It allows the Commission to contract with an independent third party to receive, process, and report data.
