**Bill Analysis**

SB 2069 prohibits any person from taking migratory birds by baiting or baiting an area where a person knows or reasonably should know that the area is or has been baited. The measure establishes a misdemeanor and provides that violators shall be subject to a \$250.00-\$750.00 fine and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 10 days. Hunting and fishing licenses shall also be revoked for a 1-10 year period for a first violation and 3-10 years for a second violation if the person is convicted of such a misdemeanor.
