**Bill Analysis**

SB 2071 broadens “dairy farm” as it relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act to include all operations that use hooved mammals to produce milk rather than specifically cows or goats. The measure increases the fee assessed against each 100 gallons of milk from \$0.01 to \$0.02. The measure expands the list of federal agencies the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may cooperate with in implementing a dairy inspection and grading program to include the United States Department of Health and Human Services, the United States Public Health Service, and the United States Food and Drug Administration.
