**Bill Analysis**

SB 2078 creates the Oklahoma Diesel Engine Freedom Act. The measure declares any federal regulation executive order, or mandate requiring the use of diesel exhaust fluid in diesel engines operating solely within the state as null and void. The measure prohibits any political subdivision or state officer from enforcing federal law on diesel exhaust for such engines. The measure also provides that no state agency, political subdivision, or officer of this state shall prohibit or restrict the production, sale, or use of non-diesel exhaust fluid engines. The measure establishes a \$500.00 fine for the first offense, a \$1,000.00 fine for the second offense, and a \$2,500.00 fine for the third offense. The measure also repeals a provision of law relating to emission control systems.
