Bill Analysis

SB 2080 requires the clerk of any municipality that is located in a county with a population of 450,000 or more residents to electronically submit on a weekly basis copies of building permits and certificates to the county assessor for the county in which the permit was issued. Towns and counties are also authorized to administer fees for the county assessor for the administration of project plans from entities within incentive and increment districts to cover costs. The measure provides that the county assessor shall serve on project committees as a nonvoting member. The measure requires the governing body granting any exemption or incentive relating to such projects to annually submit a fiscal impact report electronically to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The Department shall submit a report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor. The measure also authorizes several required forms, notifications, and documents of county offices to be sent in electronic form.
