Bill Analysis

SB 2088 expands the list of government actions relating to prohibited regulation of firearms and firearm components to include any order, policy, ordinance, resolution, or regulation. The measure authorizes the court to require the person, municipality, agency, or political subdivision to pay court costs, expert witness fees, and attorney fees to the aggrieved party in a civil action filed relating to such regulation. The aggrieved party must provide written notice of the unlawful order, policy, ordinance, resolution, or regulation by certified, first-class mail or service of process to the clerk of the municipality or to the designated agent and allow the offender to withdraw the regulation within 90 days of the notice.
