Bill Analysis

SB 2090 authorizes any person who possesses a valid handgun license to carry a concealed handgun into or upon any public college, university, or technology center school building or property in which or on which the person is authorized to be. Such carry shall not be denied to the person unless the relevant institution can provide evidence showing that the licensee has previously been involved in a violent incident or an act that showed deliberate or reckless disregard for the health or safety of the faculty, staff, students, or any other person. The measure authorizes a public college, university, or technology center school to prohibit a person from carrying a firearm if they do not possess a valid handgun license and the prohibition is restricted to event venue where a ticket of monetary value is required for entry. The measure clarifies that shall not be considered part of an employee's job description or within the employee's scope of employment when an employee carries or discharges a firearm. The measure provides immunity to civil liability for complying with its provisions.
