Bill Analysis

SB 2095 prohibits any person from assisting any other person in the taking of game for compensation or other consideration without carrying written landowner permission to do so. The measure establishes a \$500.00-\$1,500.00 fine and/or a maximum term of imprisonment of 30 days for violators. The fine and maximum term of imprisonment increase to \$1,500.00-\$2,500.00 and 6 months for a second offense. The measure provides for a revocation of the violator's hunting and fishing license for 1-10 years for the first offense and 3-10 years for the second offense. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to landowners hunting on their own property.
