Bill Analysis

SB 2125 excludes the transportation of raw ungraded milk from the provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act. The measure also clarifies that the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not prevent the advertisement of raw ungraded milk. Such milk must be produced by livestock maintained on the premises from which the ungraded raw milk is advertised for sale or sold at a farmers' market. The measure requires ungraded raw milk sold at a farmers' market to be registered with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. Sellers must notify consumers that the product is not licensed, regulated, or inspected prior to delivery. The measure repeals a section of law requiring a person transporting raw ungraded milk to obtain a permit.
