**Bill Analysis**

SB 2139 directs county clerks to remove discriminatory language from an existing plat after the adoption and recording of an ordinance amending a recorded plat. The municipality must also provide an Affidavit Regarding Correction of Plats. The affidavit shall contain the corrected title, a reference to the book and page number in which the existing plat has been recorded with the county clerk's office, location information relating to the plat, recitation of the language removed, and a copy of the existing plat.
